Words Their Way Language

<u>Sorting-</u> organizing words into groups based on similarities in their patterns or meaning.

<u>Oddballs-</u> Words that cannot be grouped into any of the identified categories of a sort. Students should be taught that there are always words that "break the rules" and do not follow the general pattern.

<u>Vowel-</u> (represented by V)

<u>Consonants-</u> (represented by C)
